The author of Hebrews teaches us we are united with Jesus as one family in our suffering and death. Are there any family members who need your support and comfort this week?

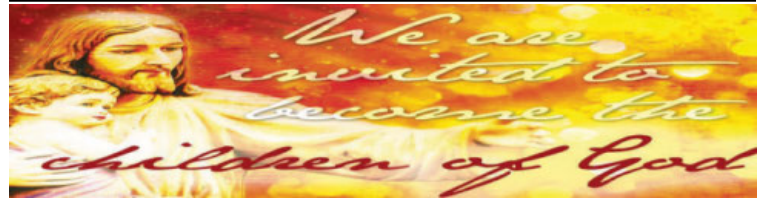
GOSPEL READING MK 10:2-16

 In addition, a total of \$7,700 in ASAP checks will be issued to these pregnancy centers by K of C Supreme, as a result of our fundraiser. Also, an additional \$3,375 was received by the Women's Care Center from the Erie Community Foundation after we made a large portion of our donation to the WCC through Erie Gives. Thus, our three pregnancy centers received \$108,075 as a direct result of our 2024 Baby Bottle Fundraiser. Thanks to all of you for this incredible effort. God Bless!
