Online Donation Safety - 'Tis the season for charity scams: How can you tell what's a scam?

Charity scammers want to get your money quickly. They often pressure you to donate right away and ask for cash, gift cards, cryptocurrency or wire transfers. Scammers often refuse to send you information about the charity, won't answer questions or explain how the money will be used. They might even lie and say you've already made a pledge to donate. If you receive unsolicited emails from charities you have never heard of or have no association with, do not respond and do not click on links contained in them. Instead, verify the charity's legitimacy by using its official website. You can report financial fraud to the FTC here: <u>https://</u> <u>ReportFraud.ftc.gov</u>. Be sure to read this article for more ways to recognize charity scams.
