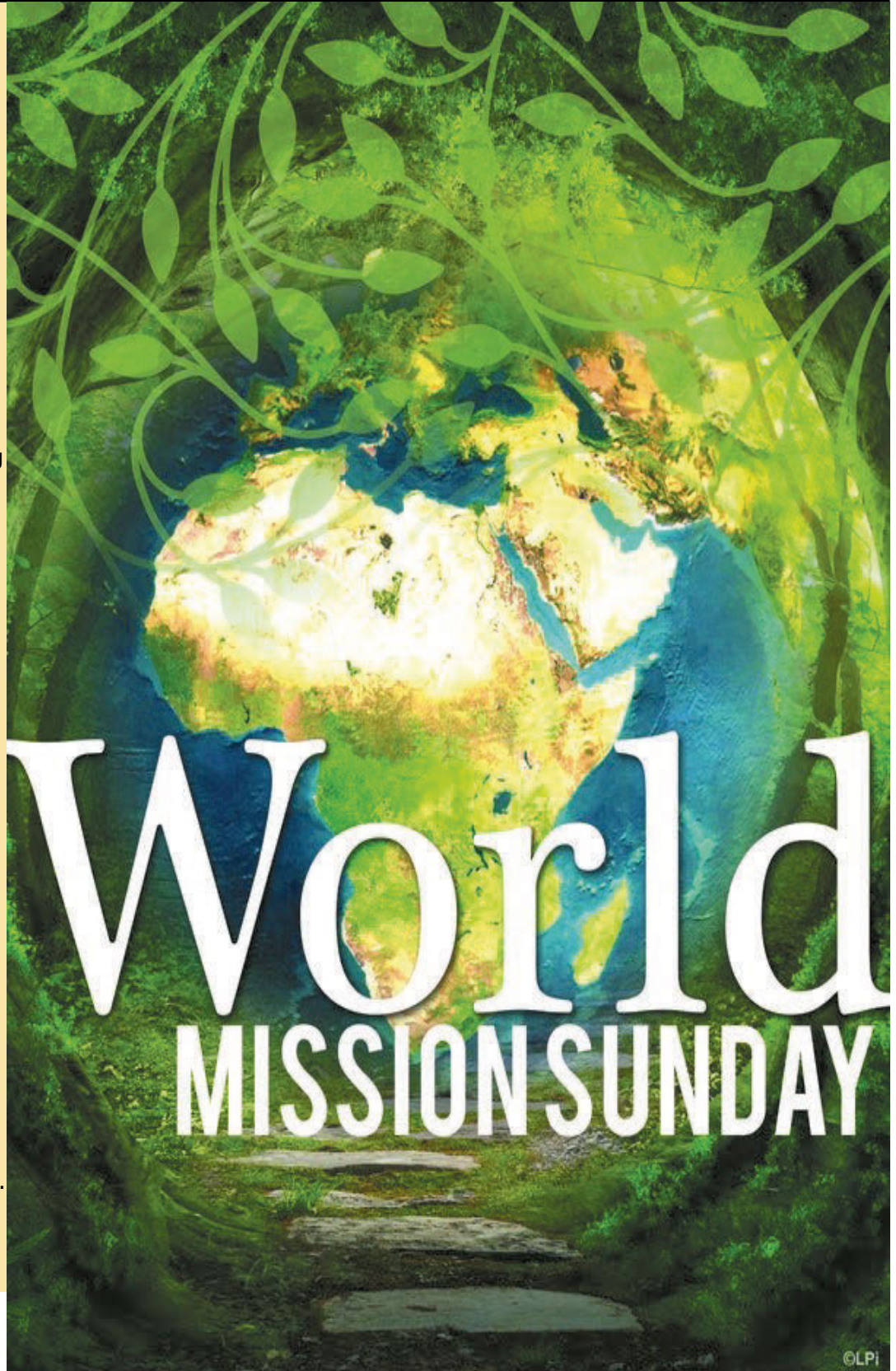

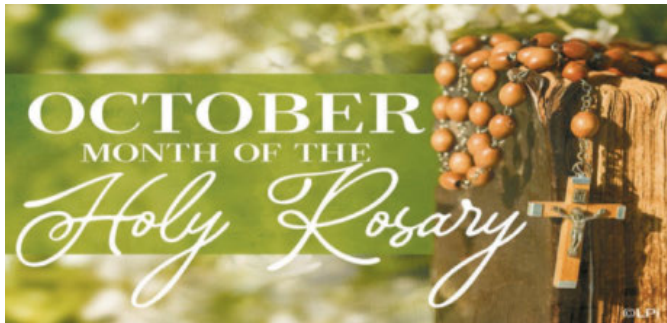

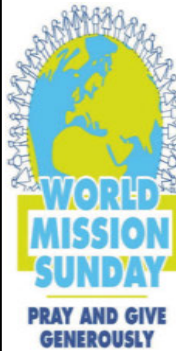
Seminary Discernment Weekend retreat
