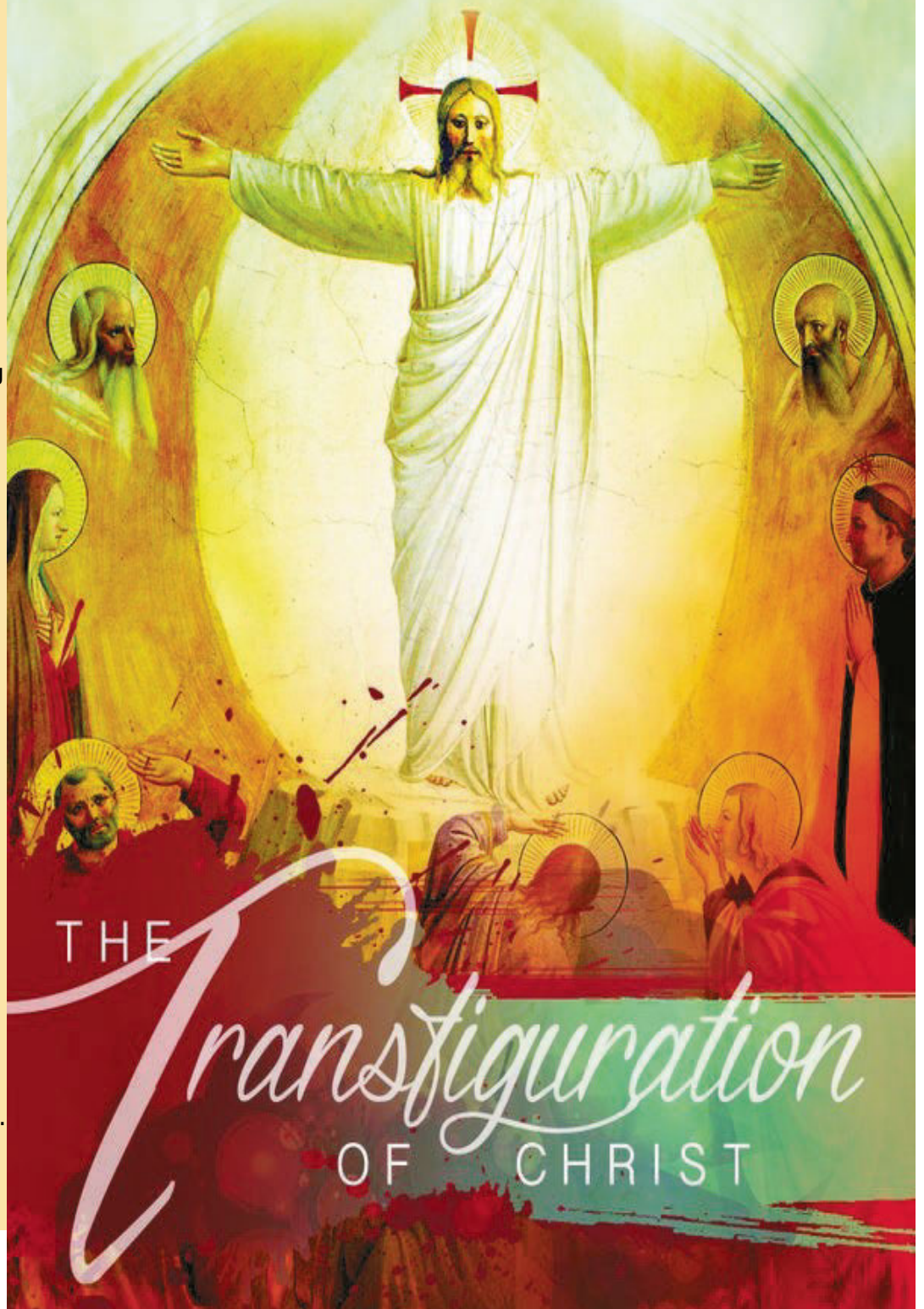

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

The Apostles do not realize what is happening during the transfiguration. They are confused and afraid, and then they hear a voice from the cloud: "This is my chosen Son; listen to him." Sometimes in life, all we have is the voice of God. Listen to it.

Lenten challenge: This week, identify one time when you experienced an awareness of some specific aspect of Jesus — perhaps on a retreat, at Mass, in prayer or in an act of service. Spend ten minutes consciously re-living that experience in your heart. If you can't recall one, set aside at least two hours this Lent as a mini retreat, either alone in nature or in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. Focus on him and ask him to share the secrets of his heart with you. He will. Then, as his friend, share the secrets in your heart. — Father John Muir ©LPi

On March 28-29, 2025, the Diocese of Erie will again celebrate **24 Hours for the Lord**, an initiative of our Holy Father with an emphasis on adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the Sacrament of Reconciliation. St. Peter Cathedral will have its doors open for the event from after the 5:15 PM Mass on Friday, March 28, to 3:30 PM on Saturday, March 29, with adoration and confession available during that time. Bishop Persico has asked that this year’s 24 Hours for the Lord be devoted to prayer for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life in the Diocese of Erie.

All Saints Parish is being asked to fill 2 different times during the 24 hours to make sure there are at least 2 people adoring the Lord during those hours. At 7:00 PM on Friday until 8:00 we will be with St. John the Baptist Parish. We are also asked to be there after the 8:00 AM Mass on Saturday morning from 8:30 to 10:00 AM with St. Peter Cathedral Parish. Please sign the paper in the gathering space if you are willing to be there. There is no limit to the number of people there for adoration.
