LIVE THE LITURGY

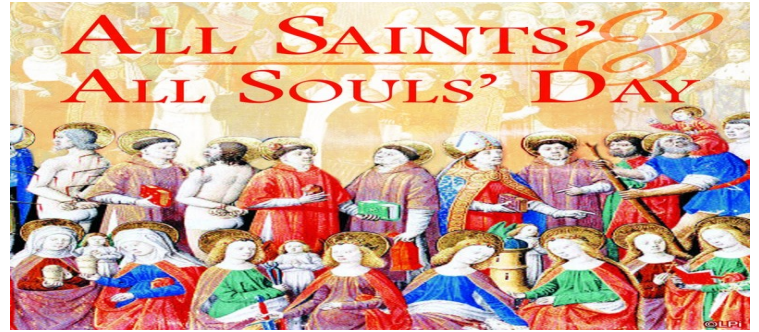
Bartimaeus called upon Christ, even when everyone scolded him to be silent. He was not afraid to ask God for what he needed, and his courage was rewarded.

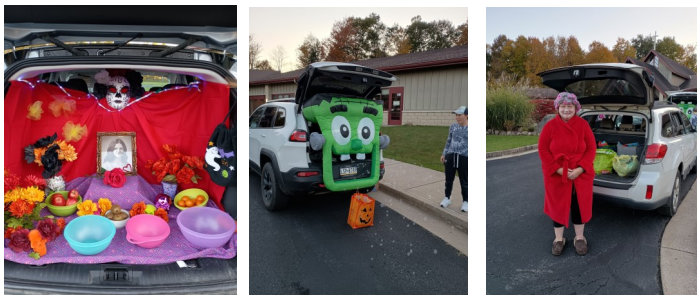

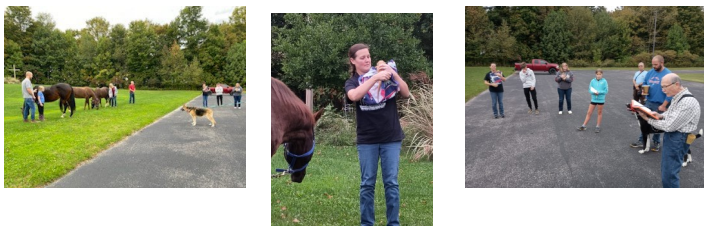
A Family Perspective
