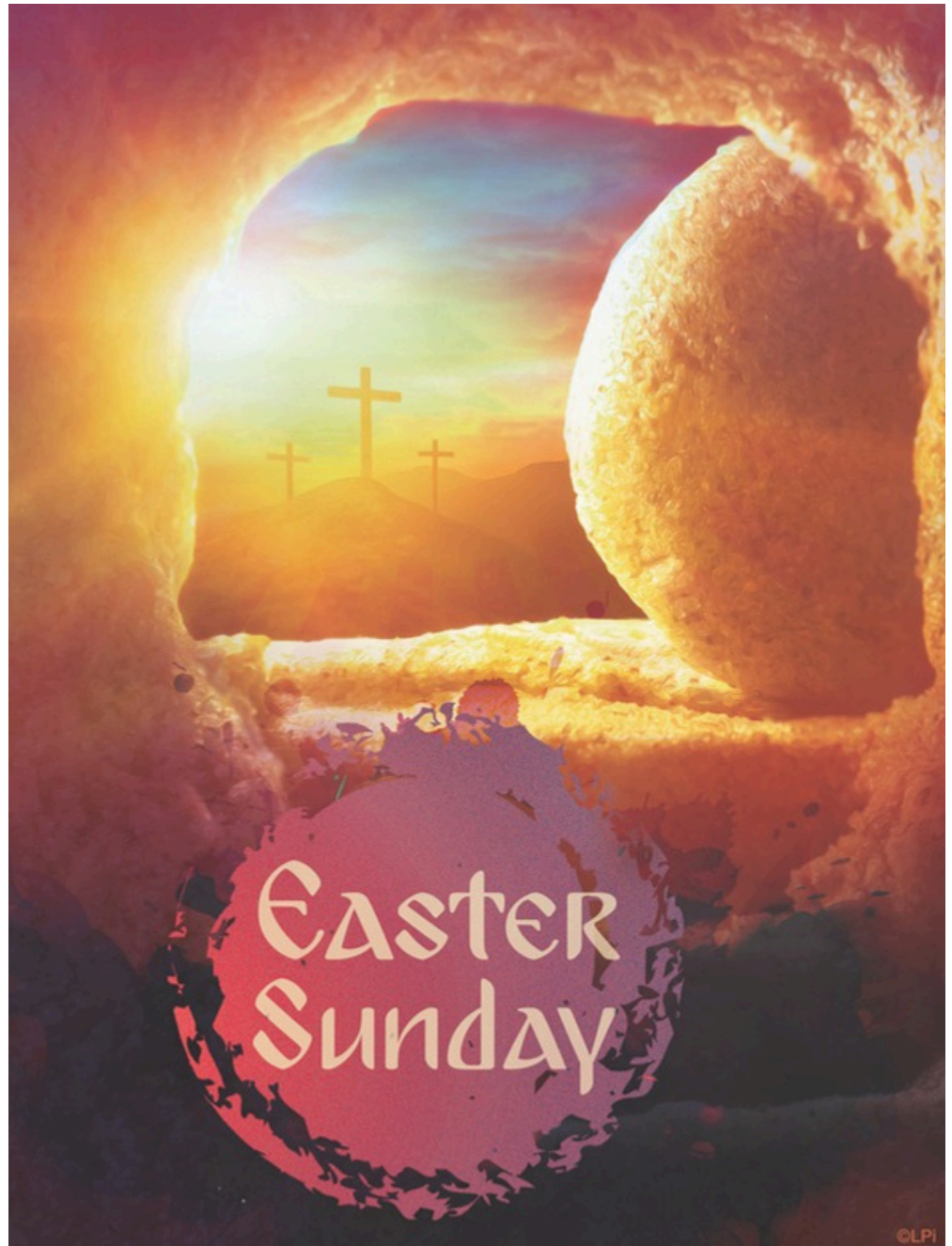

If you still have your family's baptismal candles and certificates, display them during the first two weeks of Easter.
