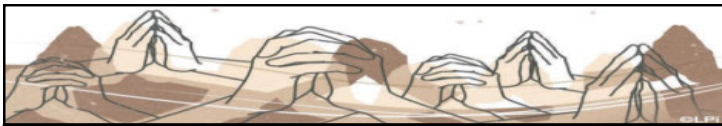

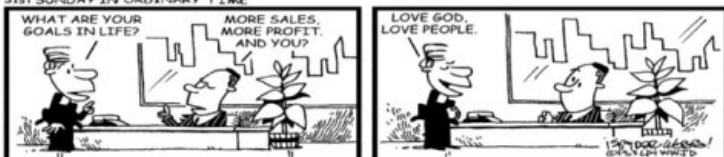
National VOCATION AWARENESS WEEK
