Palm Sunday, April 12 & 13. Palms will be distributed in the gathering space and Mass will begin there. If you are unable to stand you may go to your seat in the church.

The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery.

Holy Thursday, April 17, 7:00 PM, Mass of the Lord's Supper. Mass ends in silence as the Blessed Sacrament is transferred to the place of repose in the chapel. The faithful are invited to spend some time in adoration in the chapel. Adoration will end at 9:00 PM.

Good Friday, April 18, 2:00 PM Service, The Celebration of the Lord's Passion. This service includes the Liturgy of the Word, Adoration of the Cross, and distribution of Holy Communion. After genuflecting to the cross, the faithful leave in silence.

The Easter Vigil, Holy Saturday, April 19, 8:30 PM On this holy night, the Church keeps watch, celebrating the resurrection of Christ in the sacraments and awaiting his return in glory. It is the turning point of the Triduum, the Passover of the new covenant, which marks Christ's passage from death to life.

Easter Sunday, April 20, 9:00 AM Christ is Risen!

On March 28-29, 2025, the Diocese of Erie will again celebrate 24 Hours for the Lord, an initiative of our Holy Father with an emphasis on adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the Sacrament of Reconciliation. St. Peter Cathedral will have its doors open for the event from after the 5:15 PM Mass on Friday, March 28, to 3:30 PM on Saturday, March 29, with adoration and confession available during that time. Bishop Persico has asked that this year's 24 Hours for the Lord be devoted to prayer for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life in the Diocese of Erie. You may visit the Cathedral at anytime during those 24 hours.

All Saints Parish is being asked to fill 2 different times during the 24 hours to make sure there are at least 2 people adoring the Lord during those hours. At 7:00 PM on Friday until 8:00 we will be with St. John the Baptist Parish. We are also asked to be there after the 8:00 AM Mass on Saturday morning from 8:30 to 10:00 AM with St. Peter Cathedral Parish.
