HOW OFTEN SHOULD I GO TO CONFESSION? Catholics are required to receive the sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year. You should genuinely consider coming to Confession more often than once annually (perhaps once a month). The more frequently you go, the easier it becomes: your soul is cleansed and strengthened, you become better at examining your conscience, and more grace becomes available to you. Make time this penitential season of Lent for this sacrament.
